



Military Surplus Vehicle Inspection

A VEHICLE LABELED FOR "OFF-ROAD USE ONLY" CANNOT BE CONVERTED FOR ON-ROAD USE WITH THE EXCEPTION OF AN OFF HIGHWAY TWO-WHEELED MOTORCYCLE (REFERENCE FORM VP-254). NRS 482, 484D, 486

INSTRUCTIONS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Complete the form below to title and/or register a Military Surplus Vehicle. Corrections on Part I of the form will not be accepted. If you make a mistake, a new form must be completed.

- The vehicle must be brought to a full-service Nevada DMV to determine if it is street legal.
- All parts of this form must be completed.
- A Nevada Registered Garage, Licensed Nevada Body Shop, or Rebuilder must complete Part I.
- All inspection items in Part I must be checked "PASS," indicating the item is in a safe operating condition before the vehicle can be registered and/or titled.
- Moving permits will not be issued unless Part 1 is complete.
- The vehicle owner must complete Part II.
- A Nevada DMV Inspector must complete Part III.
- Ownership documents must accompany this form.

Ownership documents for a title:

- Title or SF97-1 (the United States Government Certificate to obtain a title), must be turned into the DMV to be issued a Nevada title prior to obtaining Nevada registration.
- If the vehicle was purchased out of state from an auction or dealer, a purchase contract must be presented to confirm sales tax was collected.

Documents for registration:

- A current title in your name.
- A current out of state registration, if applicable.
- A passing emission test, if applicable.
- Nevada proof of insurance.

Steps for completing the Military Surplus Vehicle Inspection VP-17. These steps must be followed to avoid delays in the processing of a title and/or registration.

1. The DMV VIN inspector must physically inspect the military surplus vehicle to determine if it is street legal, photographs will not be accepted.
2. The DMV Emissions Lab must check the engine to confirm it is street legal compliant and if a passing emission is required.
3. Part 1 safety inspection is completed by a Nevada licensed Garage, Body Shop or Rebuilder.
4. Part 2 is completed by the customer in front of a DMV technician when processing a title and/or registration.
5. Part 3 VIN inspection must be completed by a DMV VIN Inspector, a moving permit may be obtained once part 1 is complete with all safety equipment.
