

CDL CERTIFICATION FOR WAIVER OF SKILLS TESTS

Waiver is ONLY valid for one year after discharge or for active duty, National Guard or reserve members who are currently licensed and are or were employed within the last year in a military position requiring operation of a military motor vehicle equivalent to a commercial motor vehicle (CMV)

- Following a vehicle ahead too closely
- Reckless driving
- Improper or erratic lane changes
- Excessive speeding (15 mph or more above the posted speed limit)
- Violating a State or local law or ordinance on motor vehicle traffic control prohibiting texting while driving a CMV
- Any violation for Railroad Highway Grade Crossing
- Driving a CMV without obtaining a CDL
- Violation arising in connection with a fatal accident
- Driving a CMV without the proper class of CDL and/or endorsements for the specific vehicle group being operated or for the passengers or type of cargo being transported
- Violating a State or local law or ordinance on motor vehicle traffic control restricting or prohibiting the use of a hand-held mobile telephone while driving a CMV
- Driving a CMV without a CDL in my possession (An individual shall not be guilty of this offense if they provide proof that they held a valid CDL on the date the citation was issued; proof must be provided to the law enforcement authority who issued the citation before the individual's court appearance date or before the deadline to pay any fine for the cited violation.)
- A conviction for a violation of any military, state or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic control, other than a parking violation, arising in connection with any traffic crash, and has no record of a crash in which they were at fault.
