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## PRIVATE BIDDER IDENTIFICATION CARD INFORMATION

"Private Bidder Identification Card" means:

An identifying card issued by the Department to a private individual at least eighteen years of age, not licensed as an automobile wrecker, dealer, or rebuilder, to enable the individual to bid to purchase a vehicle, other than a nonrepairable vehicle, from an operator of a Department licensed salvage pool.

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### APPLICANTS

1. An applicant for a Private Bidder Identification card shall not be a licensed automobile wrecker, dealer or rebuilder.
2. An applicant for a Private Bidder Identification card must be at least eighteen years of age.
3. Prior to bidding on a vehicle at a salvage pool, a Private Bidder Identification card holder shall file copies of his driver's license, business license, if applicable, and proof of social security or tax identification number, with the salvage pool.
4. A Private Bidder Identification card holder shall not:
  - o Purchase more than three vehicles in any calendar year from a salvage pool.
  - o Purchase a vehicle for resale.
  - o Bid on a nonrepairable vehicle.
5. Non-refundable fee.

6. Private Bidder Identification cards expire on December 31 of each year.
7. Upon the purchase of three vehicles in a calendar year by the card holder, the Private Bidder Identification card shall become invalid. The Private Bidder Identification card may be made valid again at the start of the new calendar year and with the payment of the annual fee.

### SALVAGE POOLS

1. Report of vehicle sales made to private bidders must be submitted monthly, by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the following month.
2. Report shall be submitted electronically on a Department approved form.
3. The report shall contain the Private Bidder Identification card, the card holder's full name and address, the year, make and VIN of the vehicle sold, and the date of the sale.
