- This application must be completed by a Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) inspector.
- The VIN assignment fee is two dollars (\$2) and must be paid at the time of OHV registration.
- Except for VIN assignments, OHV transactions <u>cannot</u> be completed at DMV offices. All forms and fees must be mailed to the DMV at the address above or taken to a licensed Nevada OHV dealer.
- Your assigned Vehicle Identification Number will be mailed to you along with installation instructions.
