PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR

VEHICLES

EXPLANATION - Matter in italics is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: § 1, NRS 483.347.

A REGULATION relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles; increasing the fee to cover the actual cost of production of photographs for drivers' licenses and identification cards; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law requires the Department of Motor Vehicles, by regulation, to increase the fee as necessary to cover the actual cost of production of photographs for drivers' licenses and identification cards. (NRS 483.347) Under existing regulations, this fee is \$3.25. (NAC 483.900) Section 1 of this regulation increases the fee to \$3.50.

Section 1. NAC 483.900 is hereby amended to read as follows:

483.900 1. To cover the actual cost of production of photographs for drivers' licenses and identification cards, the Department will charge and collect, in addition to the fees charged pursuant to NRS 483.410, 483.820 and 483.910, [\$3.25] \$3.50 for the issuance of an original, renewed, duplicate or changed driver's license or identification card.

- The money collected pursuant to subsection 1 must be deposited in the State Treasury for credit to the Motor Vehicle Fund and must be allocated to the Department to defray the increased costs of producing drivers' licenses and identification cards pursuant to NRS 483.347.
 - As used in this section, "photograph" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 483.125.
